This year we have a new format to continue to encourage PhD participation in the AES annual conference. Selected PhD presentations will be incorporated into the main conference, primarily in discussion paper sessions.

PhD students at any stage of their studies are encouraged to participate. To apply, please submit a 500 word abstract of your talk through the main conference website in the discussion paper format.

In addition to questions and verbal feedback during the sessions, PhD presenters will be marked by selected members of the audience. The best PhD presenter will be awarded with a prize of £100.

Objectives

The objective of moving PhD presentations into the main conference is to increase the opportunity for feedback from senior economists.

Participants will also benefit from meeting as a PhD group at a plenary session given by a keynote speaker on the topic of career development in economics.

Organisation

We aim to schedule all PhD presentations and the PhD career development talk on Tuesday 25th April. However, we would encourage students to stay for the whole conference to learn and network.

The cost of the conference is charged at the normal student rate, see website for details. AES membership fee will kindly be waived for students who are presenting in the PhD slots.
