Conference Registration from Monday 15th April

Registration will take place in the Ramphal Building from 09.15hrs. Check-in for your accommodation is at the main Conference Reception, located in the atrium of the Student's Union Building next to The Rootes Building unless you are staying at Scarman which has its own reception desk. A left-luggage store will be available in Conference Reception and in Ramphal as access to bedrooms is not available until 15.00hrs.

At conference registration in Ramphal you will receive your delegate information for the conference and your badge. Please wear your badge at all times, as it allows entry to the restaurants, helps with security and enables you to identify fellow delegates. Please note that all conference sessions take place in the Ramphal building.

Accommodation – main campus ONLY

En-suite singles will be located in either Jack Martin or Arthur Vick your room will be available from 15.00hrs and luggage can be stored until this time. Your key will be available from Conference Reception in Rootes. All rooms have tea & coffee making facilities, hairdryer, towels and toiletries. Rooms must be vacated before 09.30 hrs on the day of departure.

Late arrivals: *If you are arriving after 21:45 please collect your room key from the Security main gatehouse located on the entrance to campus. The main gatehouse is manned 24hrs a day. When you reach the gatehouse please press the door open button on your right-hand side to enter the gatehouse. Once inside use the phone directly in front of you, a member of security staff will ask for your name and event you are attending. Your key will then be brought out to you.*
