Navigating the website for the conference material:

**Prior to the start of the conference:**

From Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> March you will be able to view the conference program from your members area if you are a subscribed member. Please take the time to familiarise yourself with the program content and the way it will be presented. This includes:

- Viewing the timetable of sessions and presentations.
- Clicking through using the  icon to read the papers being presented in their relevant sessions.
- Finding out more about the presenter(s) from their biography.
- Ask questions or provide opinion using the 'comments' section below the paper.
- Saving a presentation to your 'favourites' by clicking the grey star to the right of the item. It will go green when saved.
- View the conference noticeboard and add your own thoughts, questions and opinions.

**During the conference days:**

All the functionality above will remain and in addition:

- A 'live' section will appear at the top of the program page. This will detail what is going on in real time and offer links to join the Microsoft Teams sessions of the moment.
- The conference program also becomes live and links to join sessions will open 10 minutes before a session is due to start and will be removed 10 minutes before the session is due to end, when the next one will open.

**Contributed Papers:** sessions = one hour and 15 minutes in total. Three speakers: approximately 20 minutes for presentation + 5 minutes question time for each speaker.

A few sessions have two papers: the above timings apply, but there is more room to be flexible.

**Discussion Papers:** sessions = one hour in total. Two speakers: approximately 20 minutes for presentation + 10 minutes for question time.

**Poster Papers:** 5 minutes.
