Conference Registration from Monday 27th March

Conference Registration will take place in the Ramphal Building from 09.15hrs. Check-in for your accommodation is at the main conference reception - Senate House unless you are staying at Radcliffe which has its own reception desk. A left-luggage store will be available in Conference Reception and in Ramphal as access to bedrooms is not available until 15.00hrs.

At conference registration in Ramphal you will receive your delegate information for the conference and your badge. Please wear your badge at all times, as it allows entry to the restaurants, helps with security and enables you to identify fellow delegates. Please note that all conference sessions take place in the Ramphal building.

Accommodation – main campus ONLY

En-suite singles will be located in Arthur Vick your room will be available from 15.00hrs-21.45hrs (If you plan to arrive after 21.45, please contact Conference Reception to arrange late key collection ccvreception@warwick.ac.uk or 02476 528910. The location of key collection after 21:45 is from the Gatehouse). Your key will be available from Conference Reception, Senate House. All rooms have tea & coffee making facilities, hairdryer, towels and toiletries. Rooms must be vacated before 09.30 hrs on the day of departure. You will be provided with a key card which will give you access to your bedroom and entry door to the accommodation block. Luggage and belongings should be removed by that time. On the day of departure, keys can be left at Conference Reception (Senate House), Rootes Restaurant (in Rootes Building) or one of the boxes situated in the entrance hall of each accommodation block.
