By Train: Wadham is a 15 minute walk from [Oxford Railway Station](#) with regular trains to and from London Paddington Station.

By Bus: Wadham is a 10-minute walk from Gloucester Green Bus station which runs regular buses from London airports.

By Car, Parking: Parking is best at Peartree park and ride

By Train: Oxford railway station is approximately a 20-minute walk away or 10 minutes by taxi.

Bikes can be hired at the train station or around the city.

Car: There is no car parking on site so we recommend using the park-and-ride system.

Conference Registration on Monday 23rd March – Wadham College

Conference Registration will take place in the LSK Atrium from 08.45hrs. A left-luggage store will be available (The Trapp room) if you have not been able to leave luggage at your accommodation in advance. At conference registration you will receive your badge, a bag, notepad and pens – there is no paper programme this year. Please wear your badge at all times, as it helps with security and enables you to identify fellow delegates. Please ensure you only attend the dates and days you have registered for, we are at capacity and we are not allowed to go over contracted numbers, thank you.

If you are only attending the part of the conference that takes place at the Examination Schools, or if the first session you will attend starts at the Examination Schools, then you should register there. You do not need to go to Wadham first to register - register wherever your attendance starts.

Presenters

If you are presenting, please bring your presentation on a USB stick, there will be laptops in every room for you to use. If you are presenting a poster, please bring it with you.
